
# **Crunchy, Not Sweet**

**Carnivore, Herbivore, and Omnivore Lesson** 





## **Carnivore, Herbivore, and Omnivore (K-2)**

Learning Objective: Students will be able to categorize animals into carnivores, herbivores, or omnivores

#### **Materials:**

- Book: *Crunchy, Not Sweet* by Amy Ward
- Illustrations from Crunchy, Not Sweet, print and cut out below
  - Animal photos, print and cut out below
- 1. Hook: Read the book Crunchy, Not Sweet (Available on Amazon.com, Target.com, Walmart.com, Barnes and Noble.com)
- 2. Draw a large **Venn Diagram** on the board. Use **labels provided** to label each section. *See below*.
- 3. **Ask:** What is a **Carnivore**? (Answer: Animals that eat meat or other animals.) Why do you think Little Tree Dude doesn't eat fruit or nuts? (Answer: Little Tree Dude is a **carnivore**.) *Place Little Tree Dude in the carnivore circle*.
- 4. **Ask:** What is an **herbivore**? (Answer: Animals that eat only eat fruit, vegetables and plants.) Do you know any animals in the story that are **herbivores**? (Answer: The inchworm.) *Place in the herbivore circle*.
- 5. **Ask**: What is an **omnivore?** (Answer: Animals that eat both plants and animals.) Which animals from the story do you think are **omnivores**? (Answer: Monkey, bird, squirrel, and fly) *Place in the omnivore circle.*
- 6. **Computer Connection:** Use a **search engine** (such as Google) to look up **the other animals** provided and add your own.




